Parking and dropping off

A reminder to please park responsibly and keep our children and community safe. I have sent another request to the parking team at the council and they will be continuing to send up enforcement officers to the area.

At Deepcar St John's two of the child sized (and imaged) parking cones have been damaged by parents driving over the bases when dropping their child(ren) off.
