Y3 Visit to Yorkshire Sculpture Park – Wednesday 18th June 2025

Dear Parents and Carers,

As part of our Y3 Art and Design unit 'Abstract Shape and Space', we have organised a trip to the **Yorkshire Sculpture Park** on **Wednesday 18th June** where the children will be involved in a full day workshop to critically consider 'What makes a successful sculpture?'

In the morning, the children will take part in an interactive tour to build their confidence in looking at and responding to contemporary sculpture. Through questioning, making and drawing, they will develop their creative and critical thinking skills as well as their sculptural vocabulary. In the afternoon, the children will put their critical and creative thinking into action as they are set a 'sculptural challenge' to create their own large-scale constructions using both natural and man-made materials.

Children need to **arrive at school at 8:30am** so we are ready to leave before 9am. We will be **returning to school at approximately 3:30pm**.

As the trip is predominately outdoors, the children will need to be **dressed appropriately for the weather**. Although we encourage the children to wear comfortable shoes and trousers, we ask that they wear school t-shirt and jumper.

Children require a **packed lunch** and a **water bottle** on the day. If your child is eligible for free school meals and you would like a lunch to be provided by school please notify the school office.

The **cost of the trip is £22.50** which includes the coach fare and the artist led workshop. Payment and consent are to be made via your ParentPay account by Friday 13th June 2025.
