Y4 Residential to The Oakes
Wednesday 18th - Friday 20th April 2026

Dear Parents/Carers,

As part of our extra-curricular activities, Y4 will be going on a two-night residential to The Oakes Holiday Centre from Wednesday 18th April 2026 to Friday 20th April 2026.

The Oakes Holiday Centre is an action packed, fun filled centre at Norton, Sheffield, based on Christian principals. It is a Georgian house set in acres of woods, lawns and a lake surrounded by parkland with all activities on site. There are a variety of activities for children to choose from including: archery, a ropes course, the 'tough mudder' obstacle course, a climbing wall, zorbing, foot golf, arts and crafts, team challenges, camp fires, radio control cars, wide games and raft building. All activities are led by The Oakes team and they have full insurance cover to do this.

As well as the above activities, there is also a daily meeting time, a little like the daily assembly we have at school, whereby talks around the Christian faith are given in a clear, exciting and relevant way. There is no pressure for children to respond to what they have heard, just as there isn't at school. However, as we are a C of E school the children will be very used to the messages they are hearing.

The cost of the residential will be approximately £154 and includes the cost of the coach, accommodation & food as well as experienced staff to deliver a range of activities that will feed your child's sense of adventure and discovery.

Payment will be set up once we have a clear idea of the number of children attending and will be available to pay in 4 installments.

Please be aware that should you sign your child up for the residential and then change your mind the providers cancellation policy will apply, and you will still be liable for the full cost.
