Dear Parents/Carers,

As part of our topic in the Autumn term 'Why do people choose to invade or settle in different lands?', we have arranged an educational visit to Jarrow Hall, Anglo-Saxon Farm, Village and Bede Museum. Jarrow Hall offers immersive learning experiences focused on Anglo-Saxon and Viking history, Daily life, Farming and St Bede and the Monasteries.

The trip will take place on **Thursday 6th November 2025**. **The coaches will leave at 7:45am**. **All children must be in school at 7:30am** to be registered by their class teacher. The coach will leave Jarrow Hall at 2:30pm and we should be back at school between **4:30 and 4:45pm**, depending on traffic. Children should come to school wearing school uniform t-shirt and jumper with warm trousers and outdoor footwear for the outdoor activities.

Children will need to bring a packed lunch with them and a water bottle. If your child is entitled to a free school meal and would like to order a packed lunch, then please notify the school office.

The **cost of the trip is £28.00** which includes the coach fare, farm tour and two workshops.
