Fundraising for Cubs of Yorkshire/ Sheffield Children's Hospital Charity

Dear parents/ carers,

The school council at Deepcar St John's and myself recently held a meeting. One of our agenda items was fundraising for the Sheffield Children's Hospital Charity. We have been allocated a cub for Pride of Yorkshire and need to fundraise £950.

The school council came up with three events

1) Dress down day

We are holding this on Friday this week. Please come dressed in clothing linked to Yorkshire or a lion.

2) A used toy and book sale

Over the half term you may be doing a spring clean. Please collect any good condition, clean toys and books and send into school from Monday 2nd March until the morning of Friday 6th March. We will then organise a stall to sell these items on Friday 6th March. Parents will be welcome to come into school at the end of the day. All pupils will need to bring money in (ideally coins) to purchase items that will be priced up to £5 with the majority being priced around the £1-£2 mark.


3) Cake sale
