

## Summer Fayre

Dear Parents / Carers,

On **Wednesday 15th July 2026** we will be having a joint Summer Fayre with Royd Nursery Infant School.

Children and parents will be able to move between the two schools, and the gate will be open.

- Parents and Carers will need to enter via the Y6 gate at **2pm**.
- Please do not arrive before this time, as we will be making sure everything is set up ready for the opening.
- The event finishes at **3.30pm** and children can leave after **3pm**.
- Years 3–5 will be sat on the field together with staff. Please collect your child from the grass areas after informing the class teacher that you have collected them. Year 6 will be helping to run the games stalls.
- If parents are not attending, children may bring money to school to spend at the fayre. Please ensure this is in a **named envelope, purse, or wallet** (not loose). Thank you.
- Children without a parent will go around with a member of staff at some point during the afternoon, as well as helping staff run the classroom stalls.
- All children will have made a product to sell.

There will be a stall selling refreshments and each class will be completing their own enterprise project.

If it is raining, we will hold the event indoors across both schools. In this case, please enter through the main entrance.

We are looking for a few parents to help serve refreshments. If you can help, even for a short time (e.g. 20 minutes), please contact the school so we can organise a rota.
